



COVID-19 UPDATE #29 – Forthcoming changes to Victorian orders

As part of Victoria’s ongoing management of the Coronavirus pandemic, Minister for Health Martin Foley has made changes to the state’s pandemic orders, with some key measures to be safely lifted and others remaining till the end of winter. These changes to the pandemic orders will come into effect from 11.59pm Friday 24 June.

Of relevance to the WARR sector, rules requiring general workers to work from home unless they are double-vaccinated will be lifted. Employers will continue to be able to set their own workplace conditions.

Positive cases must still isolate for seven (7) days from the day they took their test but may now leave home to drive a household member directly to or from education or work without leaving their vehicle. They can also leave home to get medical care, a COVID-19 test, or in an emergency.

A number of other changes have also been made to requirements around mask wearing, isolation rules, visiting sensitive settings, and vaccinations.
